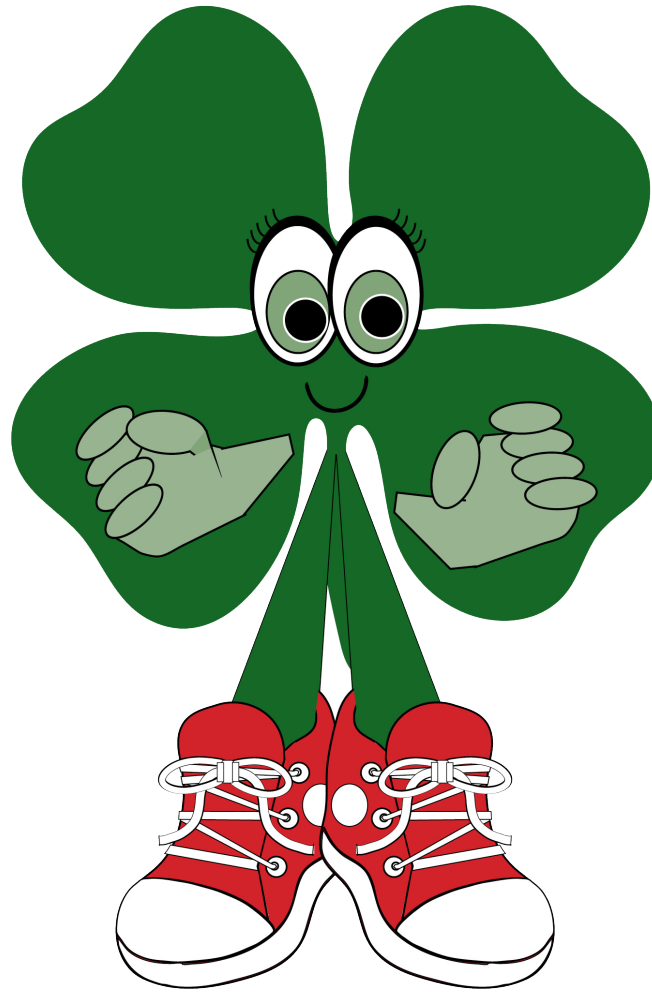

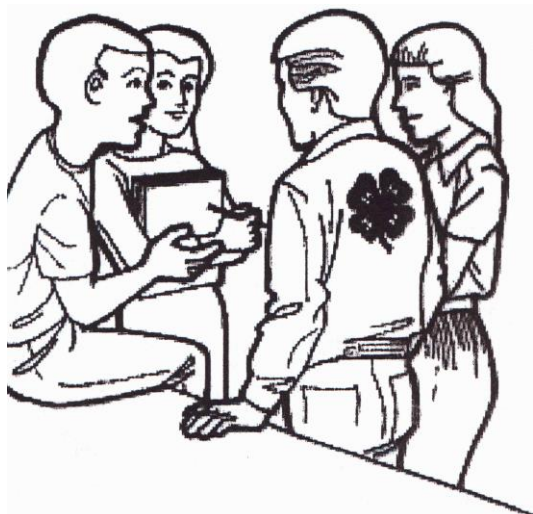

- \_\_\_\_\_ Explore the needs in your community and plan projects to meet those needs.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Fill out a different form for each Service Learning Project. Have form ready to be turned in at the April Meeting. (***Forms in this Booklet***).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Assist Song Leader as needed.
